## ANSWERS

- 1. b. 450 years old.** According to section "History" on page 8, we know that "Buenos Aires is almost 450 years old." So, the correct answer is B.
- 2. a. Northwest.** According to section "Río de la Plata" on page 14, we know that "Two large South American rivers, the Uruguay and Paraná, join northwest of here." So, the correct answer is A.
- 3. d. Narrow with round stones.** According to section "San Telmo" on page 20, we know that "I can tell that San Telmo is old because the streets are narrow and paved with round stones." So, the correct answer is D.
- 4. c. Pedestrians only.** According to section "Calle Florida" on page 28, we know that "It is a nice place to walk because the street is for pedestrians only." So, the correct answer is C.
- 5.** According to page 24, Boca Juniors play fútbol (soccer).

## TRUE OR FALSE? ANSWERS

- 1. True.** According to section "Plaza de Mayo" on page 12, we know that "From El Zanjón de Granados, it's a short walk to Plaza de Mayo. It's the oldest part of Buenos Aires." So, the correct answer is True.
