## ANSWERS

- 1. d. the "Magnificent Mile."** According to section "Historic Water Tower" on page 10, we know that "Our next stop is on Michigan Avenue. Fancy, modern buildings line this part of the avenue, called the 'Magnificent Mile.'" So, the correct answer is D.
- 2. a. The Loop.** According to section "Art Institute of Chicago" on page 14, we know that "The heart of downtown Chicago is called the Loop." So, the correct answer is A.
- 3. d. A paved pathway.** According to section "Lakefront Trail" on page 24, we know that "Many people bike the Lakefront Trail, a paved pathway along the shore of Lake Michigan." So, the correct answer is D.
- 4. b. Marsh.** According to section "Peggy Notebaert Nature Museum" on page 30, we know that "this area used to be a marsh before the city was built." So, the correct answer is B.
- 5.** According to page 10, the Chicago flag has four red stars.
- 6.** According to page 16, the *Bean's* real name is *Cloud Gate*.
