## ANSWERS

- 1. a. Boroughs.** According to section "Boroughs and neighborhoods" on page 10, we know that "New York City is made up of five main sections. Each section is called a borough." So, the correct answer is A.
- 2. c. 1,250 feet.** According to section "Empire State Building" on page 14, we know that "The Empire State Building soars 1,250 feet (381 meters) over Midtown." So, the correct answer is C.
- 3. b. 50 city blocks.** According to section "Central Park" on page 18, we know that "It was hard to miss Central Park. It covers 50 city blocks." So, the correct answer is B.
- 4. d. Copper.** According to section "Liberty Island" on page 35, we know that "The statue looks like it's covered in green metal, doesn't it? That's actually copper." So, the correct answer is D.
- 5.** According to page 38, the New York Aquarium is in Brooklyn.
- 6.** According to page 42, the New York Liberty "are the city's professional women's basketball team."
