ANSWERS

- 1. d. Grooming.** According to section "So You Want A Puppy" on page 16, we know that "A dog with long hair will need more grooming than one with short hair." So, the correct answer is D.
- 2. a. Litter.** According to section "Where Do Puppies Come From?" on page 18, we know that "The newborn puppies are called a litter." So, the correct answer is A.
- 3. c. Noseprint.** According to section "From Head to Tail" on page 20, we know that "No two dogs have the same noseprints. A dog's noseprint identifies a dog the same way your fingerprints identify you." So, the correct answer is C.

- 1. False.** According to section "So You Want A Puppy" on page 16, we know that "As a rule, females are less likely to roam than are males." So, the correct answer is False.
