#### **ANSWERS**

- 1. b. Pressure or heat. According to section "Crayon rock cycle" on page 10, we know that "Metamorphic rock forms when heat and/ or pressure cause a rock to change." So, the correct answer is B.
- **2. d. Magma.** According to section "Crayon rock cycle" on page 11, we know that "Igneous rock begins as magma." So, the correct answer is D.
- **3. a. Thin cardboard.** According to section "Egg drop" on page 19, we know that "This carrier is made of thin cardboard or poster board rolled into a cone shape." So, the correct answer is A.

- **4. c. Been preserved.** According to section "Make your own mummy" on page 22, we know that "A mummy is a body that has been preserved, or kept from rotting." So, the correct answer is C.
- **5.** According to page 130, there are 12 symbols of the Eastern zodiac.
- **6.** According to page 64, Windsor McCay was a pioneer of early animation. His most famous animated short film was *Gertie the Dinsaur*.

### TRUE OR FALSE? ANSWERS

- 1. True. According to section "Crayon rock cycle" on page 8, we know that "The horizontal rock layers seen in these cliffs show layers of sediment that have piled on top of one another over time." So, the correct answer is True.
- **2. False.** According to section "Grow your own stalactites and stalagmites" on page 13, we know that "Stalactites and stalagmites usually form in limestone caves." So, the correct answer is False.
