#### **ANSWERS**

- 1. c. Black and white. According to the section "Bird" on page 6, we know that "Your feathers are black. There are white feathers in a line across your tail." So, the correct answer is C.
- **2. b. Pink, blue, green, or red.** According to the section "Sea anemone" on page 18, we know that "You may be pink, blue, green, or red." So, the correct answer is B.
- 3. d. Bryde's whale and dolphin.

According to the section "Dolphin" and "Whale" on page 7, we know that "You swim in the water like a fish, but you are not a fish" and "Like a dolphin, you are not a fish." So, the correct answer is D.

**4. b. Great white sharks.** According to the section "Picture Key" on page 31, we know that "They can grow to more than 21 feet in length." So, the correct answer is B.
