1. b. late 1600's through early 1700's.

According to page 30, we know that, "The best-known period of pirate attacks, called the Golden Age of Piracy, occurred from the late 1600's through the early 1700's ... " So, the correct answer is B.

2. a. Caribbean Sea and Indian Ocean.

According to page 30, we know that, "The best-known period of pirate attacks, called the Golden Age of Piracy, occurred from the late 1600's through the early 1700's on the Caribbean Sea and Indian Ocean." So, the correct answer is A.

3. d. All of the above.

According to page 105, we know that, "Pirates became pirates for a few reasons. Sometimes, life at sea was so harsh that honest seamen turned to piracy. Other pirates became pirates because they wanted to have adventures ... and collect lots of treasure." So, the correct answer is D.

4. b. landlubber. According to page 111, we know that, "Landlubber: a person who doesn't know a lot about the sea." So, the correct answer is B.

5. According to page 25, we know that, "They built a ship out of boxes and toys. For the ship's wheel, they used the top of a stinky trashcan. For sails, they used the sheets normally reserved for guests. For an anchor, they used an anchor."

6. According to page 49, we know that, "The cannons were thick and Perri was pretty sure she and Archer would have to hold each other's ankles and wrists just to stretch all the way around."
