ANSWERS

- **1. b. Continents.** According to section "Our continents" on page 4, we know that "Earth is round, like a giant ball. It has seven big pieces of land called continents." So, the correct answer is B.
- **2. c. Plates.** According to section "Moving around" on page 6, we know that "Scientists say Earth's crust, or outside, is made of huge pieces called plates." So, the correct answer is C.
- **3. a. Antarctica.** According to section "Antarctica" on page 10, we know that "Antarctica is the coldest place on Earth." So, the correct answer is A.
- 4. d. Grasslands. According to section "Africa" on page 8, we know that "Africa has many kinds of land. Grasslands are the home of many animals, such as zebras, elephants, giraffes, and buffaloes." So, the correct answer is D.
