ANSWERS

- 1. b. A bat and a ball.** According to section "Baseball" on page 4, we know that "Baseball is played with a bat and a ball on a field." So, the correct answer is B.
- 2. c. Dribble.** According to section "Basketball" on page 6, we know that "Players move the ball around the court by dribbling (bouncing) or passing it." So, the correct answer is C.
- 3. a. Quarterback.** According to section "Football" on page 8, we know that "Players called quarterbacks hand the ball to another player on their team." So, the correct answer is A.
- 4. d. Outside.** According to section "Golf" on page 10, we know that "Golf is an outdoor sport played on grass on a large piece of land called a course." So, the correct answer is D.
- 5.** According to page 14, the Japanese word *judo* means the *gentle way*.
- 6.** According to page 21, ping-pong is another name for table tennis.

TRUE OR FALSE? ANSWERS

- 1. True.** According to section "Hockey" on page 12, we know that "The most popular kind of hockey is ice hockey." So, the correct answer is True.
- 2. True.** According to section "Martial arts" on page 14, we know that "Karate, judo, and taekwondo are kinds of martial arts." So, the correct answer is True.
