ANSWERS

- 1. a. Living space. According to section "Basic needs" on page 6, we know that "Almost all living things need food, water, air, and living space. This is true no matter where a thing lives." So, the correct answer is A
- **2. c. Bread.** According to section "Food" on page 9, we know that "Bread is made from the grains of some plants." So, the correct answer is C.
- **3. a. Woodchuck.** According to section "Shelter" on page 18, we know that "Woodchucks are animals that live in burrows." So, the correct answer is A.

- **4. b. Blue whale.** According to section "Did you know?" on page 26, we know that "Blue whales are the largest creatures that ever lived." So, the correct answer is B.
- 5. According to page 11, "a jellyfish is made almost entirely of water."
- **6.** According to page 21, a group of elephants is called a *herd*.

TRUE OR FALSE? ANSWERS

- **1. True.** According to section "Basic Needs" on page 6, we know that "Plants, animals, and people each have some special needs, too." So, the correct answer is True.
