ANSWERS

- 1. b. Its tail. According to section "Diplodocus" on page 4, we know that "Diplodocus used its tail like a whip to swipe at its enemies." So, the correct answer is B.
- **2. d. Pterodactylus.** According to section "Weird Creatures" on page 11, we know that "Fierce Pterodactylus soared in the air, flapping its huge, leathery wings." So, the correct answer is D.
- 3. d. Good mother lizard. According to section "Maiasaura" on page 18, we know that "Its name means 'good mother lizard.'" So, the correct answer is D.

- **4. a. Birds.** According to section "Did You Know?" on page 26, we know that "They were closely related to birds." So, the correct answer is A.
- **5.** Yes. According to page 14, Tyrannosaurus had an excellent sense of smell.
- **6.** Yes. According to page 21, Velociraptor had a tail.
