## **ANSWERS**

- 1. d. Oceans. According to section "What Is an Insect?" on page 4, we know that "They cannot live in salty oceans." So, the correct answer is D.
- **2. b. Jaws.** According to section "Beetle" on page 10, we know that "The male stag beetle has huge jaws that look a bit like a deer's antlers." So, the correct answer is B.
- 3. c. Nectar. According to section "Honey Bee" on page 16, we know that "In summer a honey bee spends its day flying from flower to flower, collecting a sugary liquid called nectar." So, the correct answer is C.
- **4. b. Tiny mosquitos.** According to section "Dragonfly" on page 22, we know that "A tiny mosquito is a favorite meal for dragonflies." So, the correct answer is B.
- **5.** As shown on page 8, the butterfly is blue.
- **6.** According to page 23, dragonflies have four wings.

## TRUE OR FALSE? ANSWERS

- **1. True.** According to section "Ant" on page 6, we know that "It lives of the damp floor of the rain forest." So, the correct answer is True.
- **2. True.** According to section "Butterfly" on page 8, we know that "The butterfly's wings are crumpled at first, but they soon straighten out." So, the correct answer is True.
- **3. False.** According to section "Praying Mantis" on page 12, we know that "A praying mantis is a fierce hunter that can measure up to 5 inches (13 centimeters) long." So, the correct answer is False.
