#### **ANSWERS**

- 1. b. Eight elephants. According to page 7, we know that "One fully grown Apatosaurus could weigh more than eight elephants." So, the correct answer is B.
- **2. a. Teeth.** According to page 12, we know that "Their teeth give a clue." So, the correct answer is A.
- **3. a. Crocodile.** According to page 21, we know that "Mosasaurus looked a little like a crocodile, but instead of feet, it had flippers for swimming." So, the correct answer is A.
- 4. b. A meteorite. According to page 26, we know that "Some scientists think that a meteorite—a huge chunk of rock from space—crashed into Earth." So, the correct answer is B.
- **5.** According to page 17, Triceratops had three horns.
- 6. Ankylosaurus. According to page 18, an "Ankylosaurus's tail ended in a bony club that it could use as a weapon."

### TRUE OR FALSE? ANSWERS

- 1. True. According to page 8, we know that "Seismosaurus was a plant eater, and it probably moved fairly slowly as it looked for food to eat from the tallest trees." So, the correct answer is True.
- **2. True.** According to page 10, we know that "Compsognathus, one of the smallest dinosaurs, was no bigger than a chicken." So, the correct answer is True.
- **3. False.** According to page 17, we know that "That's about as tall as Tyrannosaurus, who also had a mouth full of sharp, jagged teeth and hooklike claws on its hands and feet." So, the correct answer is False.

- **4. False.** According to page 18, we know that "Its body was covered with hard, bony knobs and spikes." So, the correct answer is False.
- **5. True.** According to page 22, we know that "Pteranodon had a body about the size of a turkey, but its wingspan was immense—about 26 feet." So, the correct answer is True.
