ANSWERS

- 1. c. Tall. According to page 4, we know that "The woodland oak stands strong and tall." So, the correct answer is C.

- **5.** According to page 32, katydids have eardrums just below their knees on their front legs.
- **6.** According to page 32, snakes catch smells with the tips of their forked tongues. They touch their tongues to an organ in the roof of their mouths.
