## ANSWERS

- 1. b. Jungles.** According to section "Into the Rain Forest" on page 4, we know that "Jungles are warm, rainy forests." So, the correct answer is B.
- 2. a. Jaguar.** According to section "Into the Rain Forest" on page 13, we know that "The largest animal in many jungles is the jaguar." So, the correct answer is A.
- 3. d. Feet.** According to section "Into the Rain Forest" on page 21, we know that "These frogs have sticky pads on their feet that work like suction." So, the correct answer is D.
- 4. b. Spider monkeys.** According to section "Into the Rain Forest" on page 26, we know that "The spider monkey gets its name from its long thin arms, legs, and tail." So, the correct answer is B.
- 5. Yes.** According to page 32, there are "three chief tropical rain forest regions in the world, mainly near the equator: in Africa, in Asia, and in the Americas."
