## ANSWERS

- 1. d. Warm places.** According to section "Leaf-tailed Gecko" on page 5, we know that "Geckos are a type of small lizard that live in warm places." So, the correct answer is D.
- 2. b. Europe.** According to section "Wild Grouse" on page 10, we know that "This little white bird lives in snowy areas of Europe and North America." So, the correct answer is B.
- 3. b. Scales.** According to section "Peringuey's Adder" on page 15, we know that "The sharp scales that cover its body match the yellow and brown sand." So, the correct answer is B.
- 4. a. Eyes.** According to section "Snowy Owl" on page 20, we know that "Snowy owls have big yellow eyes." So, the correct answer is D.
- 5.** According to pages 8 and 9, both cuttlefish and chameleons can change from one color to another to match their surroundings.
- 6.** According to page 15, the Peringuey's adder lives in the southwestern African country of Namibia.
