ANSWERS

- 1. d. Japan. According to the section "What Is a Ninja?" on page 6, we know that "Ninja were often from Japan's lower social classes." So, the correct answer is D.

 According to the section "What Is a Ninja?" on page 15, we know that "Shinobi used knives, bladed throwing discs or stars, called shuriken ... " So, the correct answer is D.
- **3. a. Black.** According to the section "What Is a Ninja?" on page 18, we know that "The ninja were dressed in all black." So, the correct answer is A.
- **4. c. Takigawa Katsutoshi.** According to the section "Iga" on page 37, we know that "The castle was built under the command of Takigawa Katsutoshi." So, the correct answer is C.

TRUE OR FALSE? ANSWERS

- 1. False. According to the section "What Is a Ninja?" on pages 6 and 13, we know that "Ninja were often from Japan's lower social classes. They were masters at different kinds of armed and unarmed combat" and "Samurai were the warrior class in Japan ... Ninja and samurai fought many battles against each other!" So, the correct answer is False.
- 2. True. According to the section "What Is a Ninja?" on page 17, we know that "Today, a female ninja or a woman that practices ninjutsu martial arts is often called kunoichi." So, the correct answer is True.
