- 1. c. V shape.** According to the section "What Is a Canyon?" on page 6, we know that "Canyons cut by rivers or streams typically have a V shape." So, the correct answer is C.

- 3. c. 277 miles.** According to the section "The Grand Canyon" on page 12, we know that "It is 277 miles long." So, the correct answer is C.
- 4. a. Wadi Rum.** According to the section "Other Amazing Hikes" on page 34, we know that "Because of its unearthly appearance, Wadi Rum is sometimes called the 'Valley of the Moon.'" So, the correct answer is A.
