## **ANSWERS**

- 1. a. Charles VI. According to the section "What Is a Vampire?" on page 8, we know that "In the early 1700's, Charles VI, the ruler of the Holy Roman Empire, paid scientists and doctors to search into vampire superstitions in regions of Hungary." So, the correct answer is A.
- 2. c. 13 in. According to the section "Vampire Bat" on page 16, we know that "They have a wingspan of 13 inches (33 centimeters) or more." So, the correct answer is C.
- **3. b. 5 in.** According to the section "Other 'Vampire' Animals" on page 7, we know that "The body of an adult vampire squid usually reaches about 5 inches (13 centimeters) long." So, the correct answer is B.

- **4. d. 2010.** According to the section "Other 'Vampire' Animals" on page 43, we know that "This species was first identified in 2010." So, the correct answer is D.
- **5.** According to page 10, the horror story *Dracula* was written by Bram Stoker.
- **6.** According to page 14, supernatural means "beyond what we know or understand."

## TRUE OR FALSE? ANSWERS

- **1. True.** According to the section "Vampire Bat" on page 21, we know that "The vampire bat is the only bat that shares its food." So, the correct answer is True.
