ANSWERS

- 1. d. Mouse Castle. According to page 7, we know that "The neighbor's castle was much smaller, so the count gave that castle the nickname 'Mouse' castle." So, the correct answer is D.
- **2. a. Cat.** According to page 6, we know that "The 'Cat' castle was owned by Count of Katzenelnbogen (Katz, for short)." So, the correct answer is A.
- **3. d. Gold.** According to page 10, we know that "Rumpelstiltskin could turn straw into gold." So, the correct answer is D.

- **4. c. Mouse Tower.** According to page 12, we know that "Do you remember the story of Rapunzel? She was locked up in a tower like this." So, the correct answer is C.
- **5.** According to page 14, all of the castles shown in the book are in Germany.
- **6.** According to page 3, the Rhine River is shown in the book.
