## ANSWERS

- 1. b. Red.** According to page 1, we know that "Lizzy's bike is red." So, the correct answer is B.
- 2. d. His Mom or Dad.** According to page 3, we know that "But every time Sam rides his bike, Mom or Dad has to hold onto the back." So, the correct answer is D.
- 3. b. Wind.** According to page 5, we know that "Sam is riding like the wind!" So, the correct answer is B.
- 4. c. Cry.** According to page 10, we know that "He feels that he might cry." So, the correct answer is C.
- 5. No.** As you can see on page 10, Sam falls off his bike, not Lizzy.
- 6. No.** As you can see on page 6, Sam has a horn on his bike, not a bell.

## TRUE OR FALSE? ANSWERS

- 1. True.** According to page 1, we know that "Sam's bike is blue." So, the correct answer is True.
- 2. True.** According to page 2, we know that "Lizzy can ride her bike by herself." So, the correct answer is True.

- 4. False.** According to page 5, we know that "Mom lets go of Sam's bike." So, the correct answer is False.
- 5. True.** According to page 6, we know that "Riding by himself makes Sam feel good." So, the correct answer is True.
- 6. True.** According to page 12, we know that "Now Sam and Lizzy ride side by side." So, the correct answer is True.
