ANSWERS

- **1. b. Red.** According to page 1, we know that "Lizzy's bike is red." So, the correct answer is B.

- **3. b. Wind.** According to page 5, we know that "Sam is riding like the wind!" So, the correct answer is B.

- **6.** No. As you can see on page 6, Sam has a horn on his bike, not a bell.
