ANSWERS

- **1. b. Sick.** According to page 1, we know that "'Time to get up Lizzy,' Mom said. 'I feel sick,' said Lizzy. 'I don't want to go to school today.'" So, the correct answer is B.
- **2. c. Their ball.** According to page 4 we know that "'She always takes away our ball at recess. Now we don't play ball anymore.'" So, the correct answer is C.
- 3. a. Ask Becky to play with them. According to page 10 we know that "'My mother said we should ask Becky to play with us ... Mom thinks Becky just wants to be friends,' Lizzy explained." So, the correct answer is A.

- **4. d. Under a tree.** According to page 15 we know that "Becky sat under a tree to watch them. She looked a little lonely." So, the correct answer is D.
- **5.** According to page 10, Lizzy's friends are Sara and Abby.
- **6.** Yes. According to page 16, Becky said she would like to play tomorrow.

TRUE OR FALSE? ANSWERS

- **1. False.** According to page 6, we know that "Lizzy tried to feel brave as she got ready for school." So, the correct answer is False.
- **2. True.** According to page 5, we know that "Mom says 'Maybe Becky just wants to play with you. Why don't you ask her if she'd like to play ball with you today?'" So, the correct answer is True.
- **3. False.** According to page 7, we know that "'Let's skip lunch and hide in the bathroom,' said Sara. 'No' said Lizzy. 'That won't solve our problem.'" So, the correct answer is False.
- **4. True.** According to page 13, we know that "Lizzy held tightly onto the ball. She gulped and said, 'Becky, would you like to play with us?'" So, the correct answer is True.
- **5. False.** According to page 16, we know that "When recess was over, Becky ran up to Lizzy. 'Maybe I will play with you tomorrow,' she decided." So, the correct answer is False.
- **6. True.** According to page 14, we know that "Becky didn't know what to say. No one had ever asked her to play before." So, the correct answer is True.
