ANSWERS

- 1.a. A mail wagon. According to page 7, we know that "So there I was, eight years old and on my way to the big city: Copenhagen. My mother assured me that I would be home very soon. I traveled by the mail wagon." So, the correct answer is A.
- **2.d. All the above.** According to section "The Brothers Grimm" on page 54, we know that "You are probably familiar with their most famous tales: 'Hansel and Gretel,' 'Snow White,' and 'Cinderella.'" So, the correct answer is D.
- 3.c. Snow White and the Seven
 Dwarfs. According to section "SnowWhite and Rose-Red" on pages 56 and
 57, we know that "The story inspired the
 very popular 1937 Disney movie Snow
 White and the Seven Dwarfs." So, the
 correct answer is C.

- **4.b. 14.** According to section "Copenhagen, Denmark" on page 63, we know that "I moved to Copenhagen when I was 14, in the hopes of becoming an artist." So, the correct answer is B.
- 5. According to page 7, we know that "Yes, we need money to take care of your father. Hans, my son, you must go to Copenhagen to see if [your aunt] received the letters and ask for her help."
- **6.** According to page 18, we know that "Later, Jesper told me about his experience. But he thought it was because of the bump on his head or heatstroke, not because of my hat."
