ANSWERS

- **1.b. Red boots.** According to page 7, we know that H.C.'s father gifts Karen with a pair of red boots. So, the correct answer is B.
- **2. b. Pierre.** According to page 42, we know that, when the ghost of H.C. travels into the sewers below his house, he discovers the ghost of Pierre. So, the correct answer is B.
- **3.c. The floorboards.** According to page 43, we know that " ... but luck was on my side. Peeking through the window, I saw you hide it under the floorboards." So, the correct answer is C.
- **4. a. Odense, Denmark.** According to page 46, we know that "The city of Odense is the proud home of a museum dedicated to the most famous Dane in the whole world: Hans Christian Andersen." So, the correct answer is A.
