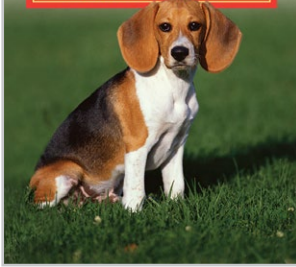

## ANSWERS
