ANSWERS

- 1. b. Scales. According to section "What Does a Clownfish Look Like?" on page 10, we know that "A fish's body is covered with scales body plates that protect the body." So, the correct answer is B.
- 2. c. 10-12 hours a day. According to section "What Daily Care Is Needed?" on page 26, we know that "The aquarium lights should be turned on for 10 to 12 hours each day, with 14 to to 12 hours of darkness." So, the correct answer is C.
- **3. d. Hawkfish.** According to section "What Is a Hawkfish?" on page 40, we know that "Unlike most fish, they do not have the inflatable organ called a swim bladder, which allows fish to float." So, the correct answer is D.

- **4. c. Western Pacific Ocean.** According to section "What Is a Mandarinfish?" on page 46, we know that "Mandarinfish are tropical fish that live in the coral reefs of the western Pacfic Ocean." So, the correct answer is C.
