ANSWERS

- 1. a. 3 inches long. According to section "What Is a Parrot?" on page 6, we know that "The smallest parrots are just about 3 inches (8 centimeters) long." So, the correct answer is A.
- 2. c. Seeds. According to section "What Does a Cockatiel Eat?" on page 16, we know that "Cockatiels love seeds ... Avoid giving your cockatiel potato chips, french fries, and other salty, fatty fried foods." So, the correct answer is C.
- **3. b. 18 to 21 days.** According to section "How Do Cockatiels Care for Their Young?" on page 28, we know that "In 18 to 21 days, the chicks (young birds) hatch from these eggs." So, the correct answer is B.

- **4. d. A moist bill.** According to section "What Are Some Common Signs of Illness in Parrots?" on page 56, we know that "A bird with a slight infection may have a moist bill." So, the correct answer is D.
- **5.** According to page 33, this photo shows a cockatoo.

TRUE OR FALSE? ANSWERS

- **1. False.** According to section "Where Do Cockatiels Live in the Wild?" on page 10, we know that "Cockatiels are native to Australia." So, the correct answer is False.
- **2. True.** According to section "How Does a Cockatiel Groom Itself?" on page 20, we know that "Like other birds, a cockatiel grooms its feathers every day." So, the correct answer is True.
- **3. True.** According to section "Which Is the Most Popular Parrot Pet?" on page 34, we know that "Budgies (budgerigars), which are one of the types of birds that are called parakeets, are by far the most popular parrot pet." So, the correct answer is True.
