ANSWERS

- 1. b. 15 to 20 members. According to section "Who Is Who in a Howler Troop?" on page 14, we know that "Howlers live in groups that usually have 15 to 20 members." So, the correct answer is B.
- 2. c. Capuchins. According to section
 "Which New World Monkeys Are Named
 After Monks?" on page 26, we know that
 "Capuchin monkeys are named after an order
 of monks that originated in Italy." So, the
 correct answer is C.
- **3. a. Night monkeys.** According to section "What Is Family Life Like for Night Monkeys?" on page 34, we know that "Unlike many other New World monkeys, night monkeys are monogamous." So, the correct answer is A.

- 4. d. Red uakaris. According to section "What Makes Red Uakaris Unique?" on page 42, we know that "The bright red faces and nearly bald heads of red uakaris are unique among monkeys." So, the correct answer is D.
- **5.** According to page 59, this photo shows an emperor tamarin.
- **6.** According to page 57, this photo shows a golden lion tamarin.

TRUE OR FALSE? ANSWERS
