

ANSWERS

- 1. d. Deep water. According to section "Where in the World Do Toothed Whales Live?" on page 8, we know that "Sperm whales like deep water — as do beaked whales." So, the correct answer is D.
- 2. b. 3 to 4 inches thick. According to section "How Does a Killer Whale Stay Warm?" on page 14, we know that "The blubber of a killer whale is 3 to 4 inches (7.6 to 10.1 centimeters) thick." So, the correct answer is B.
- **3. c. 12 dolphins.** According to section "Do Bottled-Nosed Dolphins Go to School?" on page 38, we know that "A school usually has about 12 dolphins." So, the correct answer is C.

- **4. d. Beluga.** According to section "Which Toothed Whales Are All White?" on page 54, we know that "Belugas are white when they are fully grown." So, the correct answer is D.

- 1. True. According to section "What Is a Toothed Whale?" on page 6, we know that "Oddly enough, some toothed whales have only 2 teeth, while others have more than 200." So, the correct answer is True.
