#### **ANSWERS**

- 1. a. Plastic. According to section "Introduction" on page 5, we know that "Plastic is a synthetic material and takes much longer to decompose than natural materials." So, the correct answer is A.
- **2. a. Virgin wood fibers.** According to section "Paper Items" on page 23, we know that "Most paper today is made from virgin wood fibers." So, the correct answer is A.
- **3. d. Formaldehyde.** According to section "The Bathroom: Personal-Care Products" we know that "Formaldehyde—Nail treatments; blush and face powder." So, the correct answer is D.
- 4. c. LED's. According to section "Taking Action" on page 55, we know that "According to a 2014 U.S. Energy Department study, switching all lights to LED's would save roughly two-thirds of the enormous amount of energy currently used for lighting." So, the correct answer is C.
