ANSWERS

- 1. a. Durable goods. According to section "Introduction" on page 4, we know that "Durable goods are household items, such as furniture and appliances, that are designed to last a long time." So, the correct answer is A.
- 2. d. 25% of all pesticides and synthetic fertilizers used world-wide. According to section "The Bedroom: Mattresses" on page 23, we know that the growth of conventionally farmed cotton accounts for 25 percent of all pesticides and synthetic fertilizers used world-wide." So, the correct answer is D.
- **3. d. Gas dryers.** According to section "Go Green! The Laundry Room" on page 38, we know that "Gas dryers are considered by some experts to be more environmentally friendly than electric dryers." So, the correct answer is D.

- 4. b. Electric power companies.
 - According to section "Go Green! The Yard" on page 54, we know that "In some U.S. states, homeowners who install solar panels can sell back energy to electric power companies." So, the correct answer is B.
