ANSWERS

- 1. d. Atmosphere. According to section "What Is Pollution?" on page 4, we know that "The atmosphere is a mixture of gases that spreads from Earth's surface to the sky far above." So, the correct answer is D.
- **2. c. Carbon dioxide.** According to section "Air Pollution from Heating" on page 20, we know that "A typical home furnace produces carbon dioxide and other air pollutants." So, the correct answer is C.
- **3. b. Hormone.** According to section "Water Pollution from Chemicals" on page 39, we know that "Estrogen is a type of biological chemical called a hormone." So, the correct answer is B.

- **4. c. Carbon credit.** According to section "The Challenge of Global Warming" on page 57, we know that "A carbon credit is permission to produce a certain amount of greenhouse gas." So, the correct answer is C.
- **5.** According to page 60, global warming is "the gradual warming of Earth's surface, believed to be caused by a build-up of greenhouse gases in the atmosphere."
