ANSWERS

- 1. d. Limestone bedrock. According to section "How Was the Guilin Karst Formed?" on page 10, we know that "The limestone bedrock around Guilin is the remains of an ancient sea floor ... " So, the correct answer is D.
- 2. b. Southwest corner of New Zealand. According to section "Where Is Fiordland and What's Special About It?" on page 20, we know that "Fiordland makes up the southwest corner of New Zealand." So, the correct answer is B.
- **3. a. Steep valleys.** According to section "The Animals and Plants of Fiordland" on page 26, we know that "Fiordland is famous for its steep valleys, high waterfalls, lush forests, and also its abundant wildlife." So, the correct answer is A.

- 4. b. 40,000 columns of rocks. According to section "How Was Giant's Causeway Formed?" on page 32, we know that "The formation is made up of about 40,000 separate columns of rock that fit close together." So, the correct answer is B.
- **5.** According to page 38, bedrock is "the solid rock beneath the soil and looser rocks."
- **6.** According to page 38, *primeval* means "untouched or in the original form."

TRUE OR FALSE? ANSWERS

- 1. True. According to section "Where Is the Guilin Karst and What's Special About It?" on page 8, we know that "The picturesque rock formations of the Guilin Karst are found in the Guangxi region of southeastern China." So, the correct answer is True.
- **2. False.** According to section "How Was Fiordland Formed?" on page 22, we know that "The underlying bedrock of Fiordland is among the oldest in New Zealand ... " So, the correct answer is False.
- **3. True.** According to section "Where Is Giant's Causeway and What's Special About It?" on page 30, we know that "Giant's Causeway is located on the scenic north coast of Northern Ireland." So, the correct answer is True.
